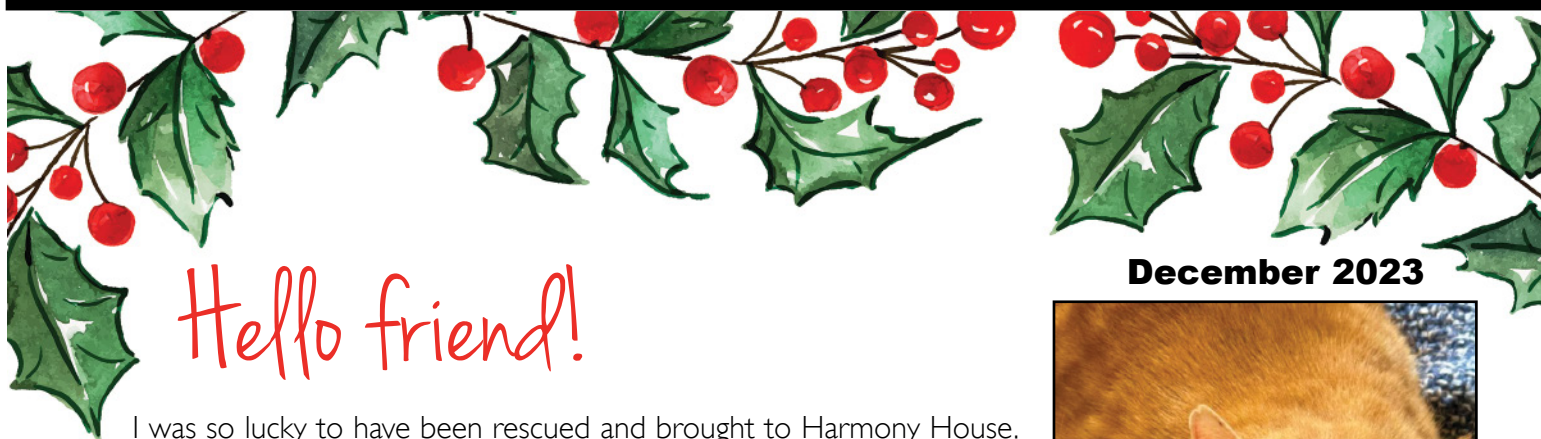

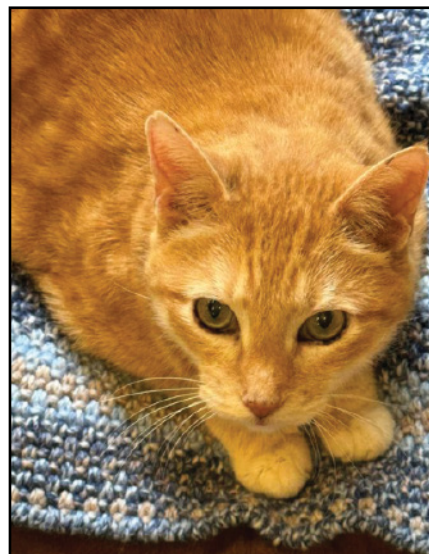


Hello friend!
